

SECTION 68 CHECKLIST

Install a domestic oil or solid fuel heating appliance, other than a portable appliance. (Part F, Section 68 Local Government Act 1993)

The following checklist will assist you to prepare and lodge a Section 68 application for a Solid Fuel Heater (PART F4, Local Government Act 1993)

Council now only accepts Section 68 Applications via the NSW Planning Portal. Please see https://pp.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/applicant-resources to register an account on the Portal along with additional information. Once registered, you can gain access to a digital dashboard which helps you to manage your applications through the online system.

Registration requires you to register your details with a valid email address. The NSW Planning Portal is not a Council owned platform, therefore if you are having issues with the system itself, please contact the support service at www.planning.nsw.gov.au/Contact-Us or call 1300 305 695.

Please be aware that the tables below outline the minimum requirements to lodge a Section 68 with Council, if such information is not able to be provided, the application will be considered incomplete and will be returned. Applicants may find it useful to engage a Private Consultant or a suitably qualified person to assist in the preparation of documentation and this is highly recommended.

Council may request further information if it is deemed necessary to continue assessment.

For each item identified below, please confirm (by ticking the appropriate column) that your application contains the required information. If in doubt, please contact Council's Planning & Building Department on 1300 087 004.

Applicant & Owner Details	You must obtain the consent of the landowner. If there is more than one landowner, every owner must sign. If the application form is not signed by the landowner(s), Council will not accept your application.			
Description of your proposal	You must describe the proposed development in detail.			
Payment of Fees	Is the payer an individual, a company, a business or a government entity? Payment should be made per the Council Fee Schedule.			
Thermal Clearance Testing Certificate or Report	A thermal testing report, applicable to the solid fuel heater to be installed in accordance with AS/NZS 2918:2018			
Floor Plan	A basic floor plan which outlines the location of the solid fuel heater and the room in which the heater is located. The floor plan should indicate how the heater will be installed as per the manufacturers installation manual and should also detail the heaters distance from all walls and details of the linings of the walls within the room, both existing and proposed.			
Elevation	An elevation plan to show termination height of the chimney/flue is in accordance with Part 12.4 of the ABCB Housing Provisions (see attached Figure 12.4.3 from the provisions in Apprendix B on page 4)			
Manufacturer's installation Manual and Guide	A copy of the Solid Fuel Heaters manufacturers installation manual and guide.			
Certificate of Compliance	A certificate of compliance from the solid fuel heaters manufacturer detailing that the heater has been tested in accordance with the relevant Australian Standards.			


