Your NEW Bin Collection Service

Your kerbside bin collection day may have changed

With the appointment of Council's new waste collection contractor JR Richards, many residents have had their bin collection day changed in 2020. Council provided bins are now emptied daily five days a week across the region. This allows Council and JR Richards to provide a consistent and quality service to our community.

This Waste Guide provides all the information that residents and commercial businesses need to know in relation to the changes to their kerbside collection and further information about how to use your bins properly, along with helpful tips about managing your household waste.

-  The garbage bin with the red lid is collected weekly.
-  The recycling bin with the yellow lid is collected fortnightly.
-  If you have a garden waste bin with the green lid, it is collected fortnightly on the opposite week to your recycling bin.

How to ensure your bins are emptied:

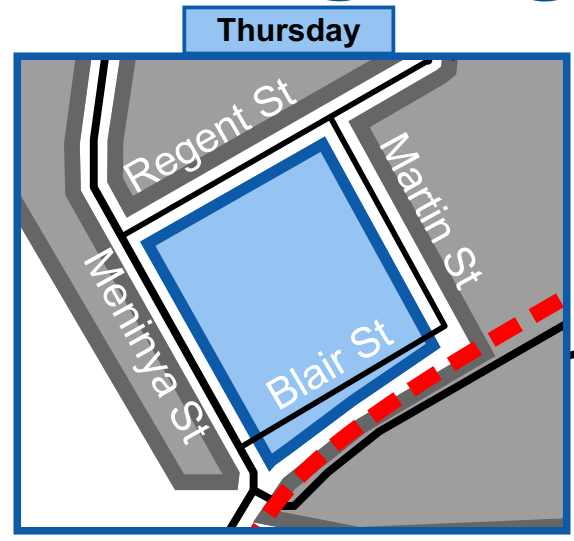
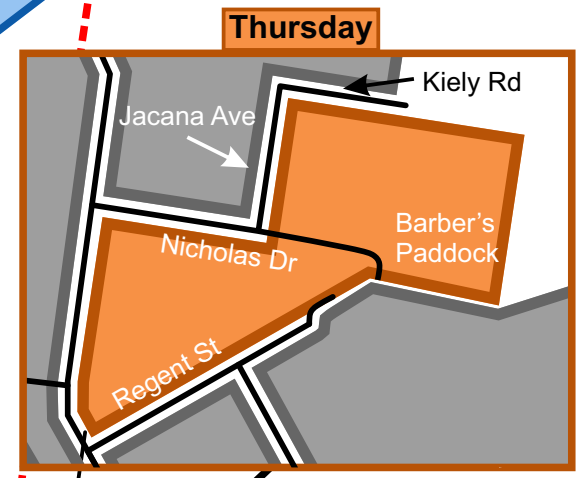
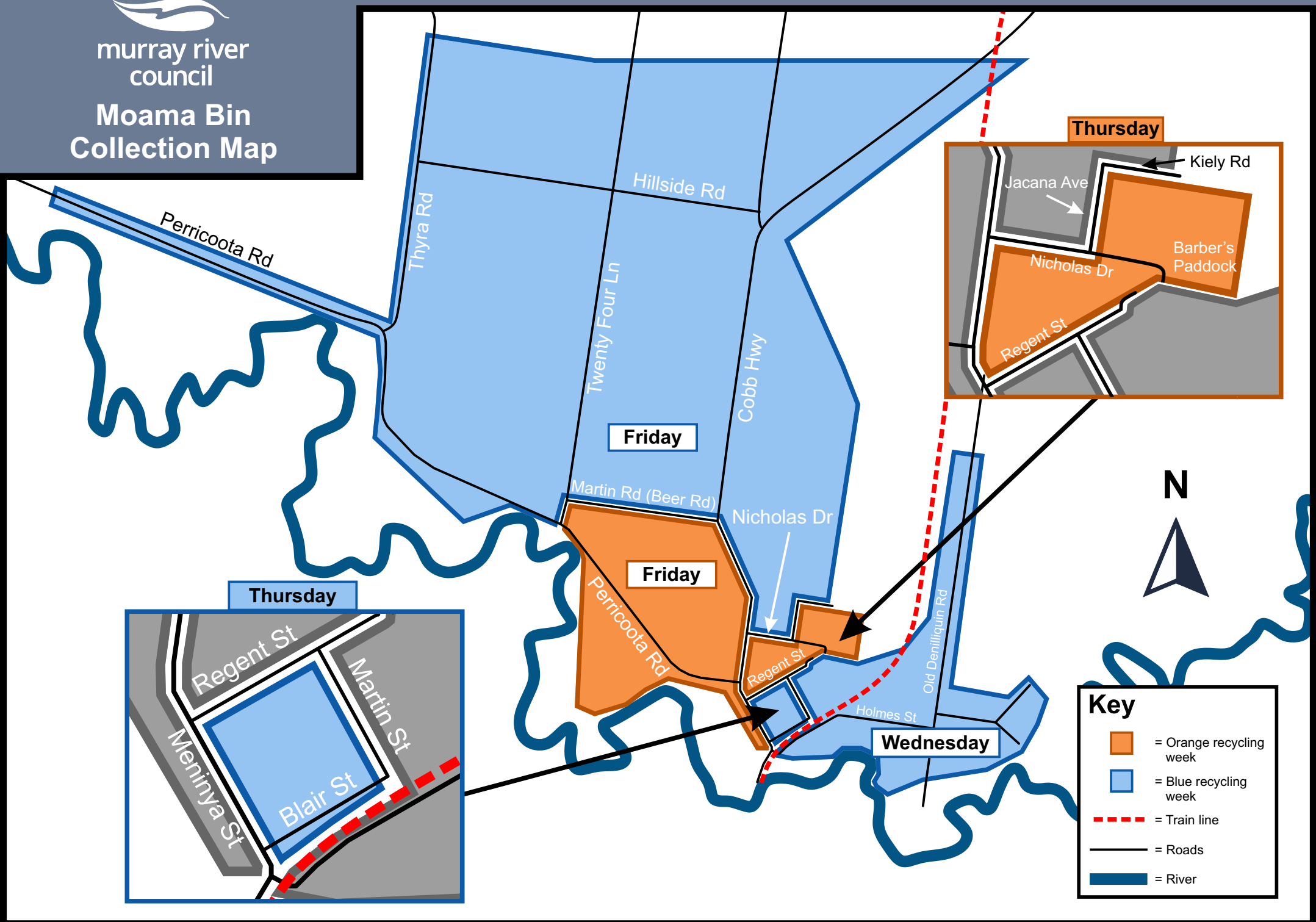
- Place your bin on the kerbside the night before collection or before 6:00am on the day of service.
- Avoid obstructions such as parked cars, overhanging branches and poles.
- Make sure your bin is not too heavy (no more than 70kg).
- Do not overfill your bins (the lid must close).
- Place your bins at least 30cm apart, with the lid opening and logo facing the street and wheels facing the property. You should be able to stand between them.

- = River

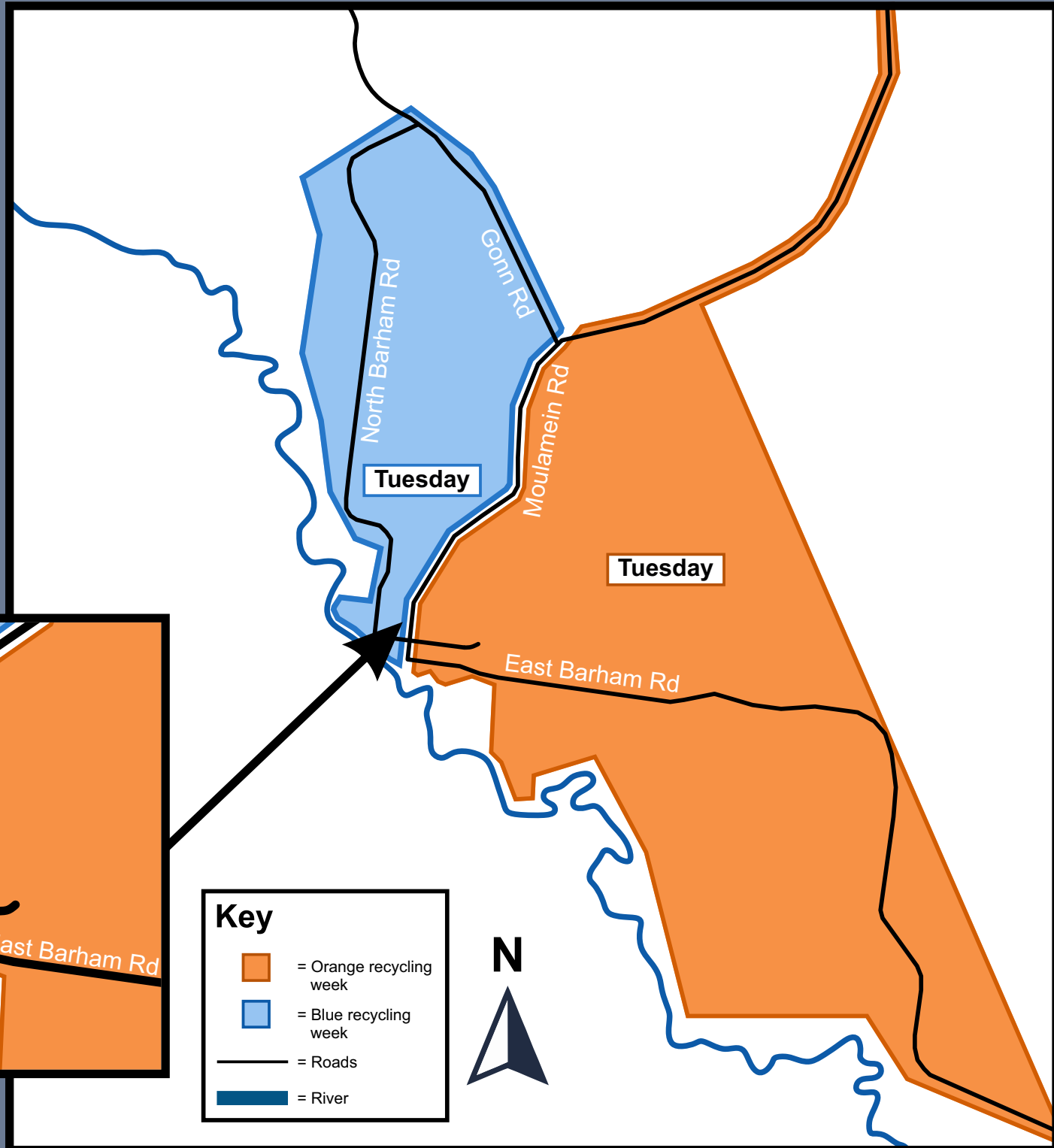
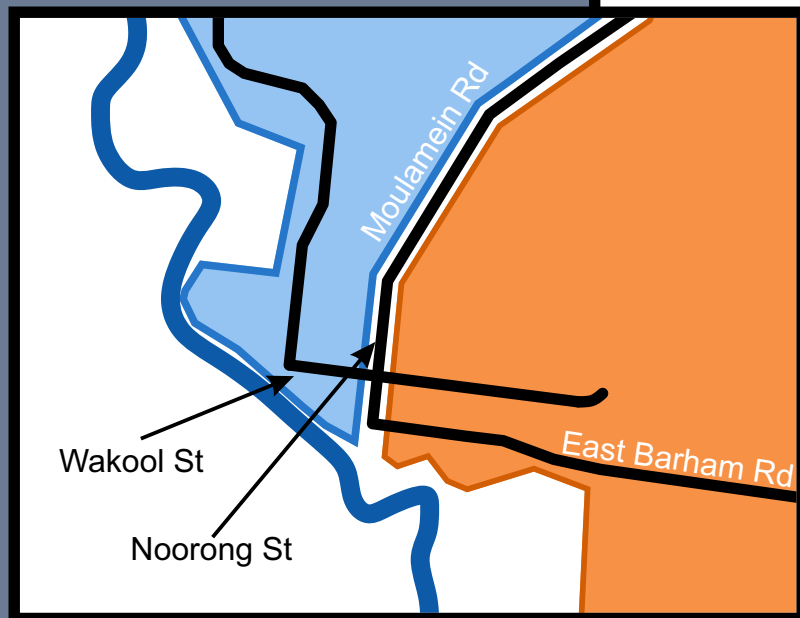

the Orange recycling week

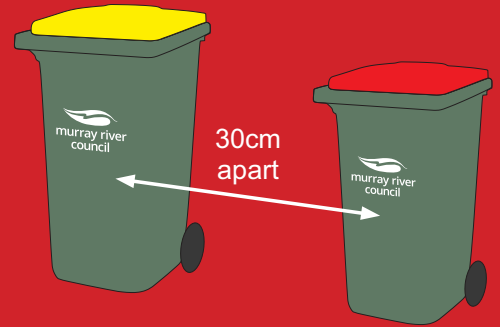




Garbage Collection Service

Bin Collection Tips

- Bins must be placed at the kerb the evening prior to your collection day or before 6am on collection day
- Bins must not weigh more than 70kg
- All bins must be approximately 30cm apart from each other and clear of cars, trees and other obstacles
- Bin lids must close completely
- Bin needs to be removed from the kerb as soon as possible after emptying







