ROAD OPENING PERMIT STANDARD CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Payment of the Road Opening Application fee as per the current Community Strategic Plan.
2. Work shall be constructed at the cost of the Applicant and in accordance with any applicable Council drawings or specifications.
3. The Applicant is responsible for the location of all existing utility services and will be liable for any damage to services.
4. Stormwater Drainage – Please check that there is no stormwater pit or pipe where work is proposed. If there is a need to modify or relocate the pit/pipe, all costs will be the responsibility of the adjoining landowner. Notify Council and do not proceed until authorised.
5. Water or Sewer Services – Check that water or sewer services are not within the proposed work area. Notify Council if any water or sewer services are found and do not proceed until authorised.
6. During construction, both the Contractor and Applicant shall ensure adequate signage, barriers and safety protection is provided to minimise safety risks at the site. The work site and works should comply with the *Work Health & Safety Act 2011* and the RMS Traffic Control at Worksites Manual.
7. All joints to existing concrete are to be level and smooth. Any lip exceeding 5mm shall be ground level.
8. Council is to be given **at least 24 hours notice** (ph.: 1300 087 004) **prior to** the following (as applicable) so that an inspection can be undertaken:-
 - a) The pouring of any concrete so that an inspection of the boxing and mesh can be undertaken;
 - b) The covering of any connection to Council infrastructure;
 - c) The covering of any pipework; and
 - d) Completion of works.
8. All disturbed areas are to be reinstated to Council's satisfaction to limit any public liability risk.
9. Should works be left in an unsatisfactory manner, all work undertaken by Council necessary to restore the site to a satisfactory condition will be charged at full cost to the Applicant.

Special Conditions
